

# How to Plant a Peach Pit

(also works with nectarines and apricots)

If you save a peach pit  
you can grow your own fruit tree.



- 1). Clean the pit and store it in the refrigerator in a plastic bag until September or October.
- 2). Place the pit about 5 inches beneath the soil surface.
- 3). In the Spring, your tree will start to grow and should be visible by July!
- 4). Keep the tree watered and fertilized (fruit tree spikes from Wal-Mart, Home Depot, etc.) and you'll have a fruit in 2-3 years!
